Sessions to include: Tribal Healing to Wellness Courts, Restorative Justice, Tribal sentencing recommendations, Diversion of criminal cases, Tribal Reentry and Community Reintegration, Opportunities for collaboration between Tribal and State Court Judges.

**Who Should Attend?** Practitioners working in Alaska Tribal justice systems, including judges, peacemakers, court clerks/administrators, council leaders, law enforcement, and reentry, treatment and victim services program staff, and State Justice system professionals who work with tribes.
